Looked-after children



There were more than **2,500** looked-after children in Glasgow in 2019, **18%** of the total number of looked-after children in Scotland.

That's **2,3%** of the child population – the highest rate of any authority within Scotland.

➔ **190** were from a minority ethnic group



➔ **326** had a disability



Child Protection Register

There were **414** children aged 0-15 on the Child Protection Register in Glasgow, in July 2019.

That's **16%** of the total number of children on a Child Protection Register in Scotland.



Children's Reporter Administration

Over **2,600** children and young people in Glasgow were referred to the Scottish Children's Reporters Administration in 2019/20.



That's **88%** of higher than the Scottish average.

Unintentional injuries



In 2014/15, Glasgow had a rate of **10.4** per **1000** emergency admissions for unintentional injuries for children aged 0-14.

- **13** per **1000** in the most-deprived decile
- **7** per **1000** in the least-deprived decile
- **8.8** per **1000** in Scotland as a whole

Domestic abuse



Between 2003/04 and 2011/12, there were approximately **269** incidents with children present recorded every month.

Around **14%** of all domestic abuse incidents were recorded as having children present.
