



# HOUSING

## Households



In 2023, there were just under **300,000** households in Glasgow. That's a **10% increase** since 2001.



2018 data show:

**44%** were single adult households.

**7%** were single adult and children.

**27%** were two adults households.



**73%** of dwellings in Glasgow are flats.

**11%** are terraced houses.

**4%** are detached dwellings.

of dwellings are thought to be in need of urgent repair (2017-2019).

of dwellings are owner-occupied.



# 17%

of dwellings are privately rented.

# 33%

of dwellings are social rented.



# 25%

of households in Glasgow were estimated to be in fuel poverty in 2017-2019.
