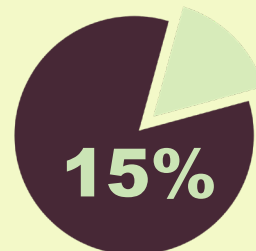

Infant death rates

Infant death rates, which were
so high in the 1850s, have
reduced steadily over the last
170 years. In 2023, the infant
death rate stood at:

Ethnicity



In 2022, **33%** of Glasgow's children (aged 0-15)
were from a non-white ethnic group.

A further **7%** were from a white ethnic group
other than 'White Scottish'.

Language



In 2022, **11%** of 3-15
year olds in Glasgow
spoke more than one
language, with a main
language other than
English being spoken
at home.
